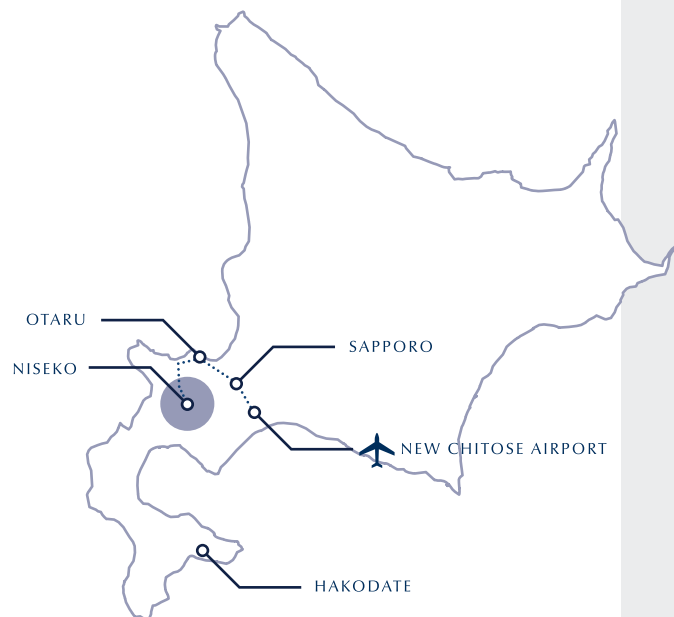
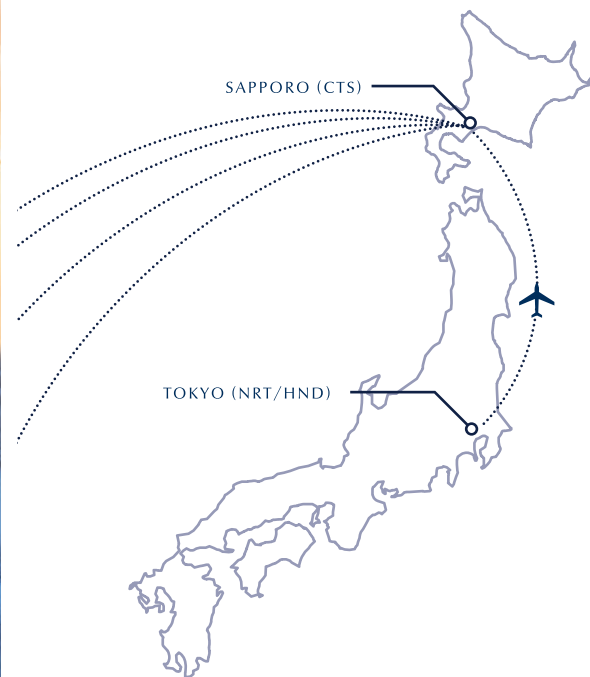
Owners of MUWA condominiums have access to personal secure year-round storage and a VIP lounge offering a refined escape. Select condominiums are also eligible for private on-site parking.

A flight from Japan's Narita International Airport takes less than two hours to reach Hokkaido.

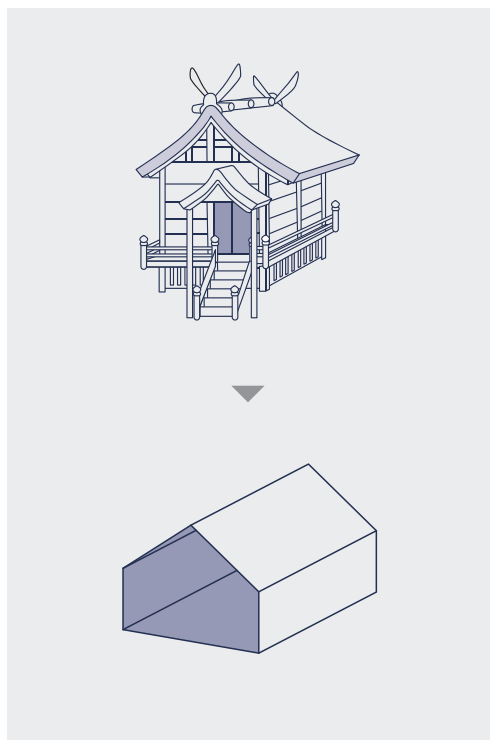

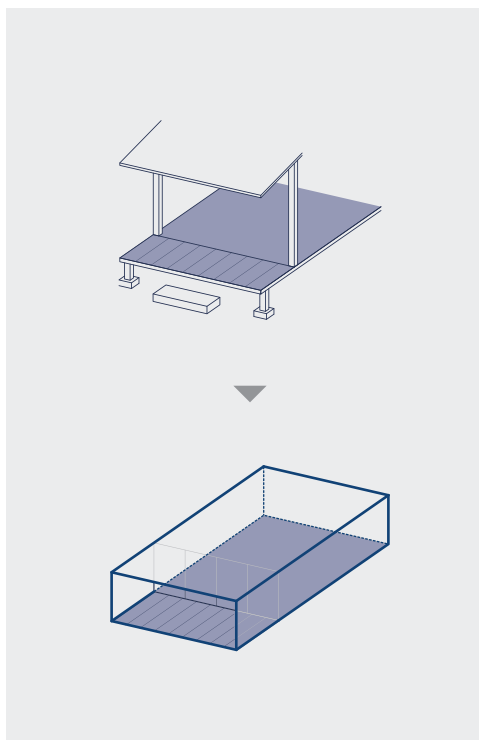
TSUMAIRI

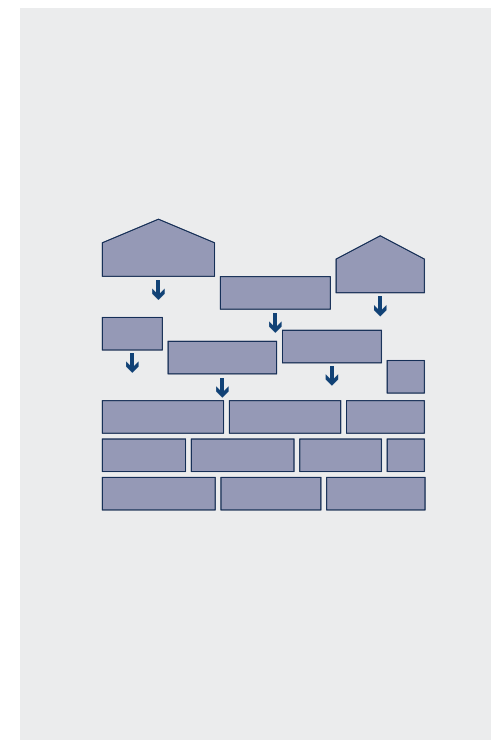
ENGAWA

Amenities located on the lower levels include underground parking, restaurants, shopping, and more.

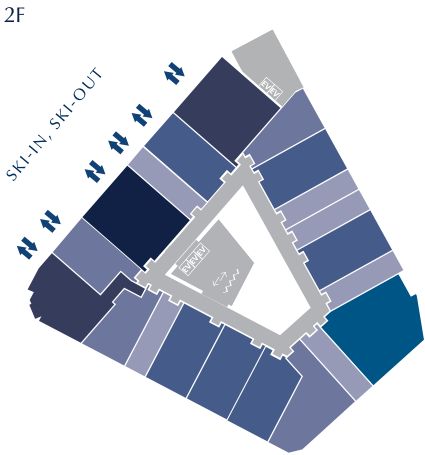
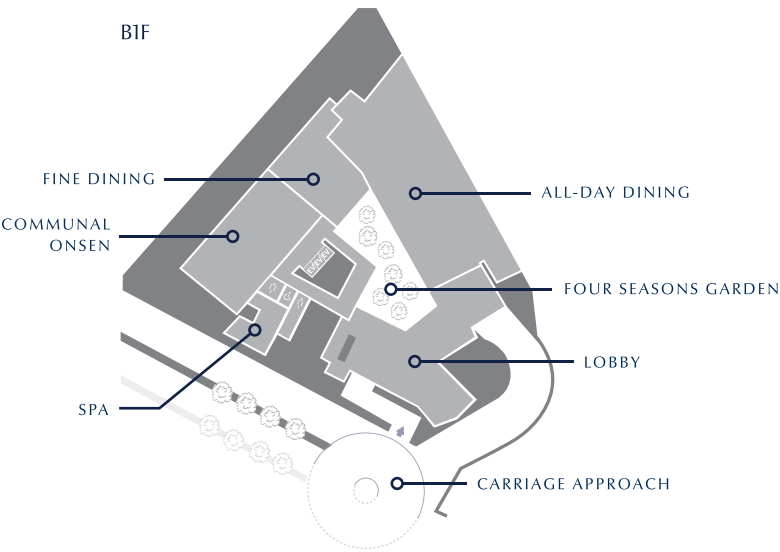
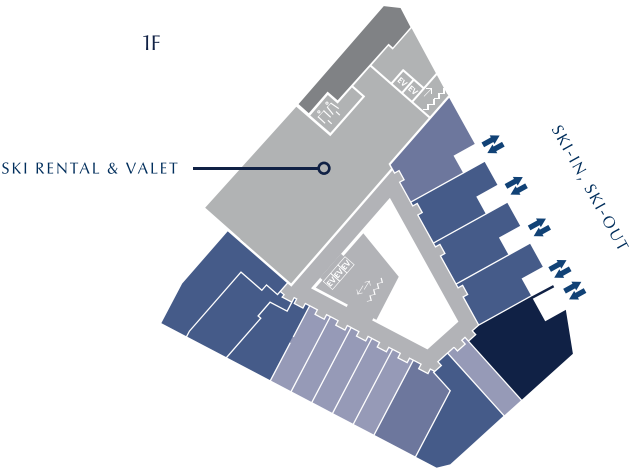
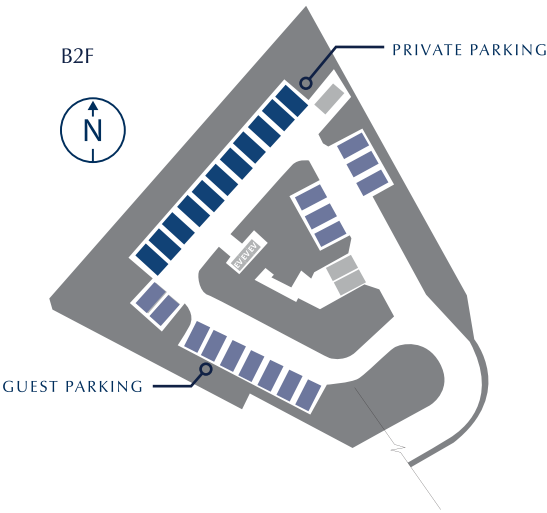
STANDARD CONDOMINIUMS 1-7F

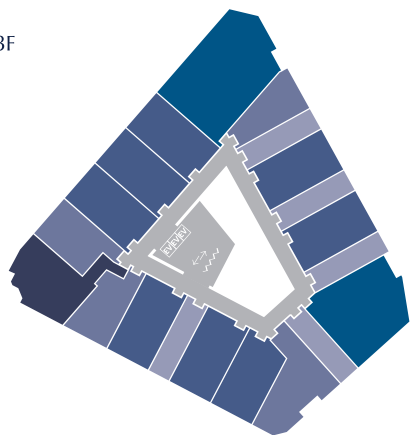
PENTHOUSE & INFINITY ONSEN 7F & 8F

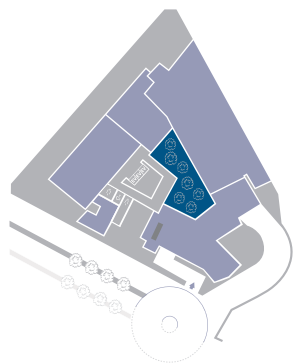
ALL-DAY DINING

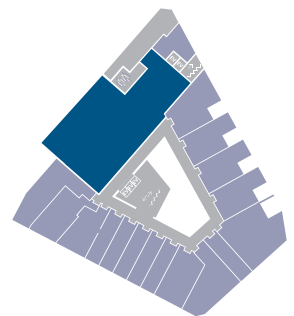
4 SEASONS GARDEN

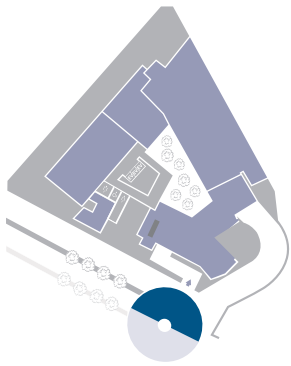

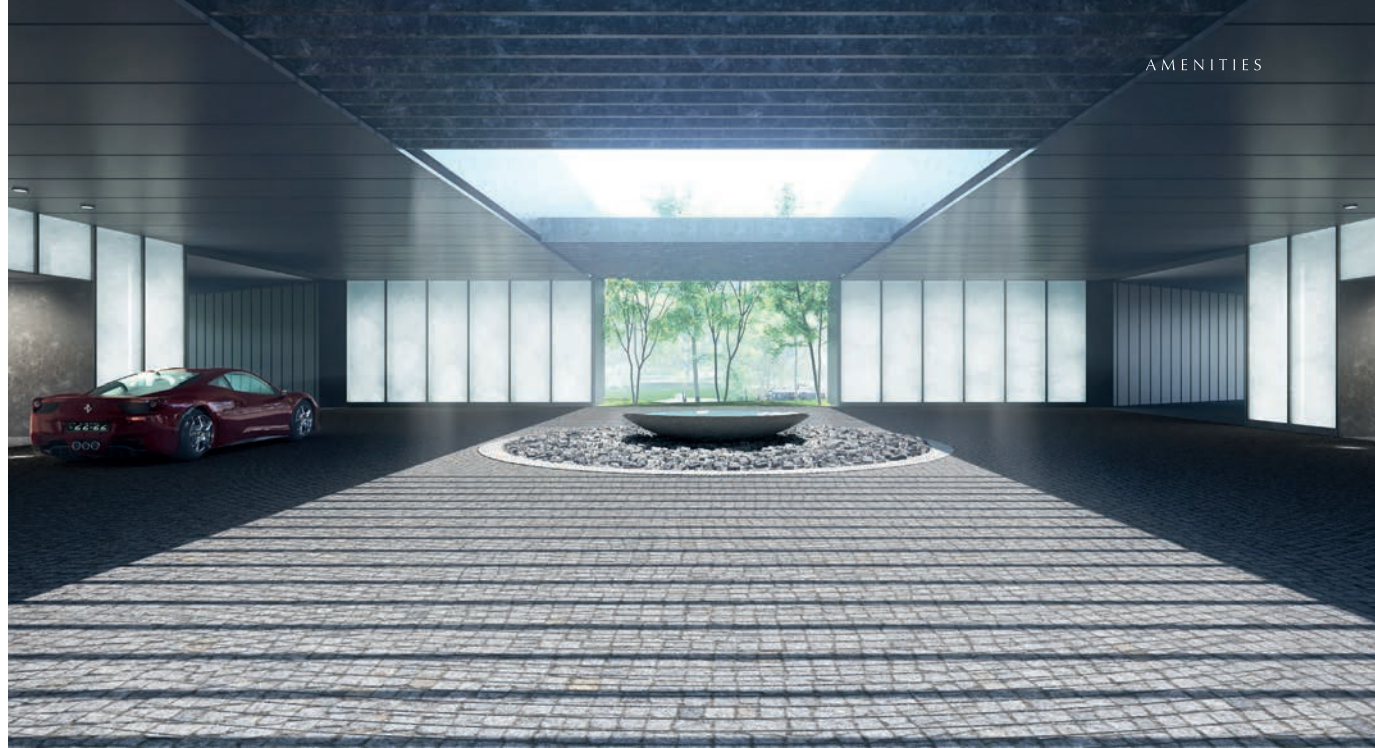

WELCOME TO NISEKO

JAPAN'S YEAR-ROUND DESTINATION

Amongst the rolling hills and mountains of the island of Hokkaido — Japan's largest prefecture — the winter wonderland of Niseko can be found. Located just two hours drive from Sapporo New Chitose Airport, Niseko comprises six separate resorts, each featuring an abundance of the world-famous powder snow, which has been attracting winter enthusiasts from around the globe for decades.

Mt. Yotei — referred to as Ezo Fuji for its striking resemblance to Japan's most iconic mountain — offers an impressive landmark for anyone visiting the region. The mountain's ancient volcanic past is deeply connected to the region's fertile farmlands, crystal-clear spring water, and wonderfully relaxing natural onsen baths. The towering peak of Mt. Yotei also acts to encourage low-level weather incoming from the west higher into the atmosphere, resulting in cooling and increased snowfall for the area.

While Niseko's place on the international stage is secured due to its lauded winters, the local appeal of the region is in its year-round offerings. Domestically, Niseko is one of Japan's most alluring travel destinations, thanks to its pleasant summer climate, captivating natural beauty, and wide selection of activities to offer. Year-round, Niseko maintains its appeal to families, retirees, and connoisseurs across the nation as a desirable holiday destination — and this four-season appeal is fast picking up momentum throughout Asia.



WINTER

Niseko's winter is world-renowned for good reason. As the sub-arctic Siberian wind travels across the sea of Japan, it creates the perfect recipe for dumping a jaw-dropping amount of perfectly light powder snow across Hokkaido. With a consistent record of delivering snow depths in excess of 10 metres per season, it's no wonder snow enthusiasts the world over travel to the region to experience the feeling of skiing in the most accessible, deep, and dry powder snow in Japan. Niseko is one of the rare places where powder is to be expected, rather than hoped for.



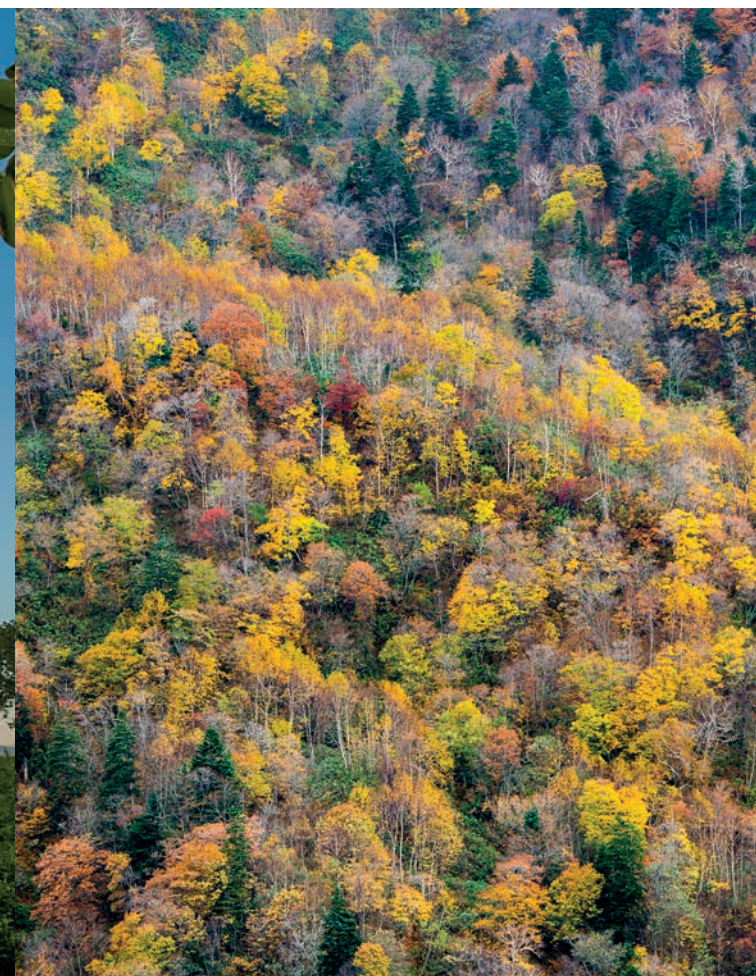
SPRING

Spring season in the Niseko region is a period where plenty of winter activities continue as the many metres of snow slowly recede. A popular time for thrill-seekers, the sunny blue skies and warmer days attract adventurous snow enthusiasts to enjoy the terrain park areas, as well as tour activities such as cat skiing, heli-skiing, snowmobiling, and snowshoeing under sunny blue skies.



SUMMER

Summer in Niseko — known colloquially as the ‘Green Season’ — often comes as a surprise to many who have only experienced the winter snow. The brilliant white winter landscape undergoes a swift transformation into a bright, green paradise as summer approaches. During this time Japanese travellers favour Hokkaido for its milder climate, and enjoy camping, hiking, and teeing-off at the many world-class golf courses in the region.



AUTUMN

Blink and you might miss it, but ask any Niseko local their favourite season and many will respond with “Autumn”. With the anticipation of winter just around the corner and the heat of Summer fading, autumn brings with it an explosion of colour as the deciduous birch, linden, and maple trees drop their leaves in preparation for winter. This season is a popular time to celebrate the fruits of the land and sea with local food festivals.



QUALITY POWDER

Well-established as one of the world's premiere ski destinations, Niseko's consistent performance in delivering record levels of ultra-light, fluffy snow has made it a top choice for winter travellers.

Niseko's unique attribute of being one of the snowiest powder resorts on the planet and long winter seasons attract many domestic and international travellers each year — all eager to experience its famed, high-quality snow for themselves.
